DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 29.07.2025.

2. At the outset, Ld. Adv. Utkarsh Singh appearing on behalf of the Respondent

GETCO submitted that the present Petition is coming first time before the

Commission and it is filed for extension of Scheduled Commercial Operation

Date (SCOD). The Respondent has recently received the copy of the Petition

from Petitioner. Hence the Respondent needs some time to file their Reply

and allow an adjournment in the present matter.

3. Ld. Advocate appearing for the Petitioner did not object to the adjournment

being sought by the Respondent. He requested to maintain status quo till the

next date of hearing in the matter, so that the connectivity remain with the

Petitioner. He submitted that the Bank Guarantee would be extended,

however, the Respondent should not take any coercive steps. He further

submitted that the Petitioner has already installed 2.1 MW out of 4.9 MW

wind capacity and fully installed 3.835 MW capacity of solar, totalling of 5.9

MW generation capacity of the 8.735 MW Hybrid -Power Project and initiated

the activities for the remaining project capacity and associated evacuation

infrastructure.

4. Heard the parties. We note that the Respondent has sought some time to file

its Reply and sought an adjournment in the matter which is not objected by

the Petitioner. As the Respondent has sought time to file the Reply, hence let

it be filed within two weeks-time with a copy to the Petitioner. Thereafter the

Petitioner is at liberty to file its Rejoinder, if any, within one weeks-time with

a copy to the Respondent.

5. We note that the Petitioner / Applicant has filed the IA for urgent listing of

the Petition, as the Petition is listed today hence we decide to dispose of IA

No. 62 of 2025.

6. We direct the parties to complete the pleadings before the next date of

hearing in the present matter.

7. The next date of hearing would be intimated separately.

8. We Order accordingly.
